You were born by His purpose and for His purpose. The desire to have your lives count for something is how God has created you...

"God has created you, he knows all about you." (Psalms 139:1-4 NIV)
"It is God who directs the lives of his creatures; everyone's life is in his power." (Job 12:10)

Yet, interestingly, most of us cannot actually state our purpose – we rely on other people and organizations to provide us with meaning and direction for our lives!

What is a Life Purpose Statement?

- 1. A life purpose statement summarizes God's purpose for your life.
- 2 It points the way, giving direction and a focus for your life.
- 3. It gives you a foundation on which you base decisions, allocate your time and use your resources.

Examples of Life Purpose Statements

- To glorify God with my life and music while being surrounded by the people I love and enjoy, and to be successful in what I love to do.
- I would love to stand in front of God with empty hands and be able to say I have used everything he has given me.
- To live my life pleasing to God and to trust and obey His ways. Help others with the help of the Lord.
- Live by the Truth.
- Go where God leads and be all I can be as a servant of His.
- No task is too great or burden too strong to keep me from reaching my destination as I stay steadfast and focused on glorifying God.
- Having God use me to my fullest potential, serving others, especially children.
- To follow God, and be successful in all my given roles.
- To find my purpose in the Lord and love others.
